



# Conditionals

## Type one

We use the **first conditional** to express real or very probable situations in the present or future.

**IF + PRESENT SIMPLE, WILL/WON'T + VERB**

**IF CLAUSE**

If the weather is fine,  
If I have enough money,

**MAIN CLAUSE**

we will play tennis.  
I'll buy a new car.
